In 1985 they opened their winery doors for the first time. Through the years, Pat and John, Jr. have been joined by 2 of their 3 children, John III and Kari. Together they have grown the business to 85 acres of grapes, across 6 vineyards in Berks and Lehigh Counties and have expanded to one of Pennsylvania's largest premium wineries.

This year Clover Hill will celebrate 41 years as a winery. Clover Hill has increased their original sales location in Breinigsville to include the Allentown Fairgrounds Farmers Market, the Boscov's Farmers Market in Reading and their wine shop at the vineyard in Robesonia. Many of their wines can be purchased in the PA Wine & Spirit Stores, Wegman's grocery stores throughout the state, and some Weis and Giant grocery stores as well.
